Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were A Child Was Left Inside of the Classroom with No Supervision and Care. (2), LA Stepped on a 4 Year Old's Foot to Show Them How It Feels if They Continue to Step on Their Peers Feet. (2), and A 2-year-old Child Was Left Alone Inside of the Classroom with No Adequate Supervision and Security. (1). None of the 12 findings were critical.
