During the Inspection Qualified Staff Were Put with the Children in Those Classrooms. (2), The Staff Bathroom Did Not Have Paper Towels. The LS Informed the Staff Member in the Kitchen That the Bathroom Did Not Have Paper Towels. Paper Towels Were Placed in the Bathroom During the Inspection. (1), and There Was an Area on the Playground That Had Weeds. One of the Weeds Was About Five Feet in Height. A Work Order Was Placed on July 10.
