Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were At the Time of the Inspection, Gate Was Not in Place at the Bottom of the Stairs. Provider Immediately Put in Place, Non Compliance Corrected. (3), At the Time of the Inspection, Specialist Observed Hair Oil in the First Floor Bathroom and Seed Plant Boxes with Potting Soil on the Floor Accessible to Children in Care. Seed Boxes Were Moved Inaccessible to Children and the Hair Oil Was Moved to Be Inaccessible. (2), and At the Time of the Inspection Provider Did Not Have Documented Fire Drills After 10/2024. (2). None of the 12 findings were critical.
