● 3 Important

Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Two Drawers That Contain Hazards in the Kitchen Did Not Have Properly Functioning Child Proof Devices. During the Inspection, the Provider Placed New Child Proof Locks on Both of the Drawers Now Making the Hazardous Items Inaccessible to the Children. Therefore, This Non-compliance Was Corrected O (1), The New Play Equipment Is Enclosed by Wooden Beams to Hold the Resilient Surfacing. These Beams Are Too Close to the Slide and Too Close to the Swings. Both Should Have a 6 Foot Fall Zone Around Each of Them. Please Remedy This Issue and Send a Picture to OCC Showing the Correction. (1), and When the Licensing Specialist Arrived at the Home, the Provider Was Outside on the Playground with Two Children Playing While the Provider Was Carrying Another Child on Her Hip. After Talking with This LS for at Least 10 Minutes, Another Non-resident Child Emerged From the Home. That Child Is a Ch (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
