The Center Currently Has 21 Nap Mats. Therefore, the Center Would Need to Have Another Nap Mat to Accommodate the Capacity They Are Requesting. However, Both Rooms Measure for a C (2), During Evaluation of the Basement to Add as a Classroom, It Was Found That the Sink Has a Space That Needs Additional Caulking and the Front of the Door to the Bathroom Needs Repair as It Has Chipping and Deteriorating Surfaces. Additionally, There Are Holes Under the Sink Around the Pipes, a Hole N (1), and The Center Structure Was Built in 1969 and Has Not Been Certified as Lead Free. During the Inspection, Chipping, Peeling and Deteriorating Paint Was Observed on the Outside of the Building as Well As, at Least, on the Window Ceils in the Two Year Old Room.
