Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were LS Observed One Staff's Medical Report Not Completed on a Form Supplied or Approved by the Office. (3), The LS Observed That the Program Didn't Have Hot Water. Rosedale's Maintenance Staff Put in a Request to Have Calvert Mechanical Come Out Today to Fix the Piping Issue. The Director Will Send the LS an Invoice to Document That the Hot Water Is Fixed, Along with Temperature Readings. (1), and LS Did Not Observe Criminal Background Check Results for Most Staff in the Staff Records. This Was Corrected During the Inspection When the Director Obtained the Results and Placed Them in the Staff records. LS Did Not Observe Proof of Age in Several Staff Records. This Was Corrected During the Insp (1). None of the 12 findings were critical.
