Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed That Some Corners of the Designated Napping Rooms 102 and 103 Were Pitch Black Which Inhibits the Ability of the Staff Members to Maintain Adequate Supervision. Additional Light Sources Were Added During the Inspection. (2), Licensing Specialist Observed 1 Instance of an Emergency Form That Had Not Been Signed by the Parents. This Was Corrected at Pickup Time During the Inspection. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed That the Approved Napping Rooms 102 and 103 Did Not Have Sufficient Illumination While They Were Being Used by the Children During Rest Period. Facility Removed the Paper Covering the Door Windows, Adjusted the Blinds, and Added Night Lights to Both Rooms During the Ins (1). None of the 9 findings were critical.
