(2), LS Observed 1 Instance of a Blank Health Inventory Part 1 Form. Facility Is Asked to Contact the Parents Again to Have It Filled Out. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed 1 Toilet That Was Continually Running and Couldn't Flush, 1 Sink Whose Sensor Wasn't Working, and 2 Soap Dispensers That Were Expelling Very Small Amounts of Soap.
