LS Also Observed Large Wood Chips in the Playground Area, and Wooden Parts Surrounding the Play Area, That A (1) and LS Reminded Facility That All Outdoor Activity Equipment Shall Be Safe, in Good Repair, Clean and Nontoxic. LS Observed Two Areas of Playground Equipment, That Need to Be Washed Due to Residue Left Behind. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
