(3), The Staff Did Not Notify Report Suspected Child Abuse to Child Protective Services in an Adequate Amount of Time. (2), and The Provider Did Not Immediately Notify the Office of Child Care That an Employee Was Suspected of Child Abuse or Neglect. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
