Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Was Unable to Review Training for the Provider. Provider Is Asked to Submit Proof of Twelve Hours of Continued Training on the Professional Development Plan and the Corresponding Training Certificates. (2), Licensing Specialist Observed Water Temperature of 137 Degrees Fahrenheit. Provider Is Asked to Adjust Water Heater and Licensing Specialist Will Come Back to Re-check Temperature. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed Provider Changing a Child's Diaper Using a Glove, and Did Not Change the Glove Between Children. Provider Is Reminded That She Needs to Wash Her Hands Between Diaper Changes and Change Gloves. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
