Licensing Gave Provider Copies of the Guide to Regulated Child Care at This Inspection. (1), One Child in Care Has Had a Lead Screening Completed but the Paperwork Was Not on Site. (1), and The First Aid Kit Had Clear Soap but It Had Fragrance. Provider to Submit a Picture of the Front and Back of Fragrance Free Soap. Licensing Gave to the Provider a List of Soaps That Are Fragrance Free at This Visit. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
