Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed a Child in Care Without the Following Documents: Health Assessment and Evidence of All Required Immunizations. (1), Provider Is Reminded That Each Child Enrolled There Shall Be a Written Record for Each Day's Attendance. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed More Than One Child in Care with an Emergency Form That Has Not Been Updated Annually. Each Child's Emergency Form Shall Be Updated as Needed but at Least Annually, and Signed and Dated by the Parent. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
