Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Ls Observed a Video of a Staff Person Picking Up a Child by 1 Arm and Taking Him to Another Area of the Room (2), Ls Observed on Video a Staff Member Carrying a Child by 1 Arm Across an Area in the Classroom (2), and LS Conducted a Complaint Inspection in Which a Two Year Old Child Was Unsupervised for Allegedly 2 Minutes. The Child Ran Out of the Classroom and Ran Into an Empty Classroom and Was Playing. At the Time of the Complaint Inspection, LS Observed Video Footage and Observed One Teacher Bring Children (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
