The Child's Water Bottle Was in Another Classroom as the Children Had Been Combined in a Room That Was Not the Ch (1), All Children's Files for Children Under 2 Years of Age Were Reviewed and a Random Sample of Children 2 and Up. 9 Children Need Updated Immunization Records. (1), and Of the Child Records Reviewed, 5 Children Need the 12 Month Lead Blood Test and 5 Children Need the 2 Year Lead Blood Test (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
