Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were LS Observed 7 Infants Receiving Care in the Infant Room. The Staff Stated That a Child Was Moved to the Infant Room Because She Was Crying. The Staff-child Ratio Must Be Adhered to at All Times. (2), LS Did Not Observe All of the Required Information on Each Child's Form. The Physician Information, Enrollment, and Days and Hours of Attendance Is Missing on Some of the Forms. Provider Must Have the Forms Corrected Immediately. (1), and Facility Is Currently Advertising That It Is a Montessori Program. Facility Is Not Licensed as a Montessori Program. LS Observed Advertising Throughout the Facility. The Director Must Remove the Term "Montessori" From All Advertising and in the Facility. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
