The Child (3), There Is One Child Who Does Not Have an Emergency Form in the File. The Provider Will Locate the Form or Have the Parent Complete Another One. The Provider Has the Child's Emergency Contact Information on File, Just Not on the OCC Form. (2), and There Are Two Children Who Are Missing Evidence of an Immunization Record. There Are Two Children Who Are Missing an Updated Immunization Record. Please Have the Parents Obtain the Information for the File and Submit a Copy to the OCC. (1).
