● 13 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Watched on the Video the Child Was Able to Watch the Teacher While Her Back Was Turned and Able to Leave the Room Unnoticed. (2), LS Saw on the Video the Teacher Had No Idea That the Child Eloped From the Classroom. LS Did See an Incident Report but the Parent Was Not Notified. (1), and LS Saw an Incident Report but It Was Never Signed by the Parent or Disclosed to the Parent the Incident Occurring. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
