Once the Emergency Forms Are Completed, Please Forward a Copy to the Li (5), At the Time of the Inspection, the Specialist Noted That There Were Clorox Wipes in the Bathrooms Upstairs and Downstairs Within Reach of the Children. If Accessed by the Children the Clorox Wipes Could Be Harmful to Them.
