(3), LS Observed No Evidence of a Lead Screening for the Child in Care. Provider to Submit a Written Statement Verifying That a Request for All Lead Screening Information Has Been Given to the Parents and the Information Is Accessible in the Child File. (1), and LS Observed No Evidence of the 2023 Basic Health and Safety Annual Update Training Being Completed by March 31, 2024. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
