(1), and The Aide at the Center Needs to Complete the 2025 Basic Health and Safety Training. It Was Due by 3/31/26. She Needs to Complete It and Submit a Copy of the Certificate to Specialist. (1). Lead Staff Are Reminded That at Least One of Them Needs to Be in the Front with the Group at All Times. This Was Corrected During the Inspection.**
