Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe an Employment Medical Evaluation for One Staff Person. (1), LS Did Not Observe Medical Instructions on an Emergency Form for a Child Enrolled in Care Who Has an EPI Pen, Albuterol, and Benadryl on Site. (1), and LS Did Not Observe a Health Inventory for a Child Enrolled in Care Who Has an EPI Pen, Albuterol, and Benadryl on Site. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
