Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Observed No Liners in Any of the Trashcans in the Children's Restrooms. (2), Licensing Specialist Observed Disrepair to the Ceiling in the Lobby. (2), and After Individually Interviewing All Staff, Two Staff Stated That They Have Seen Children in the Lunchroom Which Is Not Yet Approved on the License. LS Received Another OCC 1209 Change in Facilities Form Requesting to Approve the Lunchroom for Auxiliary Use, and to Decrease the Capacity of G/H but In (1). None of the 11 findings were critical.
