(2), Staff Member Did Not Ensure the a Child Received Adequate Supervision Appropriate to a Child's Individual Needs. The Staff Member Used Inappropriate Redirecting. (2), and Staff Member Was Seen Inappropriately Redirecting a Child That Resulting in a Injury to the Child's Left Arm "Nurse's Elbow". (1). None of the 9 findings were critical.
