Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were LS Observed 1.5 Hours of Continued Training for Previous Full Year for One Aide. Not Documented on Professional Development Plan. (2), LS Observed an Emergency Form for One Child Stating the Child Has Asthma and Requires Medication. Emergency Form Not Reviewed by Physician. Comments State "See Asthma Medication Authorization Form" but the Child Does Not Have One. (1), and LS Observed One Emergency Card Needing Physician Information. LS Observed Two Emergency Cards Needing Parent Date and Signature, Emergency Contact Information. (1). None of the 8 findings were critical.
