(3), Upon Arrival to the Home, Licensing Specialists Observed a Total of 12 Children Being Permitted to View Passive Television (Baby Shark). 3 of Those Children Were Under the Age of 2. They Were Observed Watching the Television Show for at Least 20 Minutes. (2), and Licensing Specialist Observed an 8 Month Old in a Pack and Play with a Bib, Pacifier Leash and Toys for Playtime. Provider Is Reminded That the Child Cannot Be Left in the Pack and Play to Play. Provider States They Leave the Baby There So the Other Children Do Not Step on the Infant. LS Reminded Pr (1).
