The Provider Has Stated That They Are Reluctant to Pay for the Necessary Procedures. The Provider Has Never Used Them, and May End Up Removing Them From Her AP List. One New Substitute Will Then Need to Be Found. (2), Licensing Specialist Observed 4 Instances of Children Needing Additional Lead Tests, and One Instance of a Missing Health Part II Form. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed That the Wooden Fence Has Small Gaps Between the Bars That Could Potentially Be a Risk for Entrapment. Provider Is Asked to Block the Gaps with a Barrier. (1). None of the 8 findings were critical.
