Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Observe the Fence Around the Playground and Some Tables Broken. This Is a Potential Hazard and Must Be Fixed. Program Has a Work Order for the Fence to Be Repaired. (2), The Program Must Ensure the Safety of All Children in Care. A Teacher Did Not See When Another Child Was Inappropriately Touched by Another Child in Care. (2), and A Child Observed Another Child Inappropriately Touching Another Child and Went to Inform the Teacher. Staff Must Supervise Children in the Restroom at All Times. Program Must Review Staff Supervision of Children in Care. (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
