The Shed Was Not Locked. If Accessed by the Children, It Could Be Harmful to Them. Please Keep All Potentially Hazardous Items Out of the Children's Reach, Making Them Inaccess (1), Upon Reviewing the Children's Records, the Licensing Specialist Noted That There Were Two Children in Care Missing Evidence of a Lead Test at 24 Months of Age. Please Obtain the Documentation From the Parent and Submit Evidence to the Licensing Specialist. (1), and Upon Inspection of the Outdoor Activity Area, the Specialist Noted That There Was No Secure Barrier in Place at the Top of the Stairs Leading to the Walk-out Basement.
