Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Was Not Able to Observe Individual Place to Rest That Is Not Used by Any Other Child. Licensing Specialist Observed Two Children Resting Under a Table with a Shared Blanket Underneath of Them. (1) and Licensing Specialist Observed an Infant Sleeping in a Stroller with Blankets and a Bottle, and Another Infant Sleeping in a Bouncer Chair. Licensing Specialist Immediately Told the Provider That the Child Has to Be Sleeping in a Crib or Approved Sleeping Device Without Any Potential Hazardous Object (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
