Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were At the Time of Inspection, Four Children Were Missing Evidence of Age-appropriate Lead Testing. LS Asked the Provider to Submit Proof of Age-appropriate Lead Testing for All Children. (2), At the Time of Inspection, the Provider Had Two Children Who Are Currently Two Years Old Resting in Pack and Plays. LS Requested That the Provider Move the Children Onto a Bed, Cot, Mat, or Sleeping Bag, and Submit a Statement of Correction to LS. (1), and At the Time of Inspection, a Child Under the Age of Two Was Napping on a Different Level of the Home. The Provider Had a Video and Sound Monitor to Supervise the Child. LS Discussed with the Provider That Only Children 2 and Older May Nap on a Different Level Than the Provider. LS Requested That (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
