LS Discussed That the Provider Or (2), Provider Must Conduct Fire Drills Monthly and Emergency Drill Twice a Month. LS Only Observed 2 Times That Fire Drill Was Conducted. The Provider Will Ensure That She Conducts Month Fire Inspection and Submit to Licensing Specilist (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed Two Children Missing Emergency Cards and Health Inventory 1. (1). None of the 9 findings were critical.
