Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialists Observed an Emergency Form Missing the Authorized Pick Up Person and He Health Care Provider Information. (2), The Licensing Specialist Found No Evidence of Health Inventories, Part One and Part Two for Three Enrolled in the Family Child Care. (1), and LS Was Not Able to Observe the Child Hands Being Washed After Diapering. Provider Is Reminded That the Child's Hand Are Washed Thoroughly by the Provider or the Child After Toileting and Diapering. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
