Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider's Outside Area Wasn't in Compliance. The Provider's Gate Is Broken to Walk to the Entrance of Her Program and Her AC Unit Needs a Protective Barrier So Children Recognize That They Aren't to Go Near the Unit. (2), The Provider Received Missing Immunization and Lead Test Paperwork for the Child. LS Saw Both Documents During the Inspection. The Provider Does Not Have Health Inventory Part 2 and an Updated Emergency Form. Correct Immediately. (2), and Room Temperature Is 65 Degrees F but the Provider Is Using a Heater That Is Hot to the Touch. Correct Immediately. (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
