These Forms Were Not Available for Review. Provider Called Parent and Parent Emailed Emergency Forms. After Review by Specialist Missing 2 Children Emergency Forms. These Forms Must Be Submit to Office Of (3), and LS Came Into the Daycare Area and Observed Child Sleeping in an Infant Seat. Per the Provider the Child Had Just Fallen Asleep and Was Immediately Removed From the Infant Seat. Once the Child Was Moved, the Child Woke Up and the Provider Let the Child Remain Up and Held the Child Who Was Crying at T (2). None of the 10 findings were critical.
