Provider Needs to Submit Copy to Licensing Specialist Once It Is Obtained. (2), Licensing Specialist Observed Smaller Bedroom Still Has Excessive Clutter. Licensing Specialist Unable to Open Bedroom Door Fully. (2), and Provider Stated That She Still Has Not Signed Up or Completed First Aid and CPR That Was Due in February 2024. (2).
