Provider Locked Up and Removed These Items From the Child Care Area at the Time of the Inspection. (2), Specialist Observed One Child Whose Health Assessment Part 1 Was Blank and Needs to Be Completed by Parent. (1), and Specialist Observed a Gap of 4 Hours Between Lunch and the Next Snack Time (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
