Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed 4 Children's Emergency Forms Without the Required Annual Update. (2), Licensing Specialist Did Not Observe a Current Substitute Log Maintained by the Provider. Licensing Specialist Was Informed That the Additional Adult Was Out of the Country for Three Weeks in November of 2025 and a Substitute Filled in for Her. This Was Not Documented. (1), and The OCC Received a Complaint Alleging That a New Resident Moved Into the Family Child Care Home. The Complaint Also Alleges That the Additional Adult Left the Country for a Considerable Amount of Time and Never Returned to the Family Child Care Home and This Was Not Reported to the OCC. During Quest (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
