Provider Must Immediately Submit Corrections. (4), LS Did Not Observe Evidence of Lead Testing for Each Child Enrolled. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of Lead Testing or Evidence of an Appointment to Obtain Lead Testing From a Health Care Provider. (2), and LS Did Not Observe Documentation That Each Child's Parent Was Given or Advised How to Obtain the Parent Guide to Regulated Child Care. (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
