Some Children Go Home at Noon and Some Go to Nap Time a Little After That. The Room Needs to Be Sure to Keep Its Attendance Procedure Up to Date to Be Sure Not to Lose Anyone During the Transition Times. This (2), A Random Sample of Children's Records Was Reviewed. There Were 4 Children Who Need Evidence of a Lead Blood Test. (1), and A Couple of the Classrooms Need New Staffing Patterns as Staff That Were in the Room Have Left or Staff Have Switched Rooms.
