Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Specialist Has Not Received the 2025 Basic Health and Safety Training. This Was Due by 12/31/25. Provider Needs to Complete This Training Immediately and Submit a Copy of Certificate to Specialist. (3), Two Infants Need Evidence of Updated Shot Records That Show 3 DTP Shots, 3 Polio Shots, and 3 Hep B Shots. A Five Year Old Needs Evidence of Having Had an MMR Shot and a Varicella Shot. (2), and Two Children Need Evidence of Lead Blood Tests Having Been Done at 2 Years of Age or Later. (2). None of the 11 findings were critical.
