Facility Must Submit Evidence of a Complete Form for Each Child Missing Information. (2), and From the Sample Reviewed, LS Did Not Observe Evidence of Lead Testing for Each Child. Facility Must Immediately Submit Evidence of Lead Testing or an Appointment to Obtain a Lead Test. (1). None of the 9 findings were critical.
