(2), and Licensing Specialist Observed Fencing in Disrepair Next to the Deck Steps and the Bottom Step Not Attached to the Deck Steps. This Wooden Step Not Connected Has Some Nails Sticking Out. (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
