This Was Corrected During the Inspection by the Director Submitting a Delete Form for All Staff Members. (1), and LS Observed an Aide in Classroom D Serving as the Lead Teacher. LS Went Through the Staff Qualifications with the Director and Determined That the Staff Member That Was Acting as the Lead Teacher Was in Fact Not Qualified to Be the Lead Teacher of That Age Group.
