Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe All of the Required Information on Each Child's Form. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of Corrected Forms. (3), LS Did Not Observe a Health Assessment for Each Child. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of a Health Assessment Signed and Dated by a Physician or an Appointment to Obtain One. (2), and LS Did Not Observe Evidence of the Appropriate Lead Testing for Each Child Enrolled. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of Lead Testing or an Appointment to Obtain a Lead Test. (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
