Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were There Is One Child Whose Emergency Form Is Missing the Doctor's Name and Phone Number. There Are a Few Children Whose Address Is Not Written on the Emergency Form. Please Ensure That All Children's Emergency Forms Have All of the Required Information. (3), The Provider Has a Mini Trampoline on Her Deck. The Provider Is Advised That Daycare Children Can Not Use the Trampoline and It Must Be Inaccessible to the Children. The Provider Is Advised to Move the Mini Trampoline From the Area of the Deck Where the Children Play. There Is an Inflatable Pool In (2), and There Was a Lighter, a Can of Lysol Spray, and Hand Sanitizer in the Kitchen on the Counter in Reach of the Children. The LS Moved the Items So They Were Inaccessible to the Children. There Were Two Bottles of Bleach Spray, Air Freshener Spray, Disinfecting Wipes, and Lotion in the Bathroom in Reach (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
