Two Children Were Missing a Parent Signature on Part I of the Health Inventory. One Child Was Missing Record of Immunizations. Provider to Submit All Completed Documentation to LS. (1), and At the Time of Inspection, LS Observed 4 Hours of Training for the Provider From 10/01/2022 - 09/30/2023. Provider Is Asked to Complete 8 Extra Hours of Training for a Total of 20 Hours Between 10/01/2023 - 09/30/2024, in Order to Make Up the Missed Hours. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
