Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were From the Sample Reviewed, LS Did Not Observe a Separate Emergency Form for One Child; The Emergency Form Included Both Siblings, LS Did Not Observe a Daily Pick Up Person for One Child. Facility Must Immediately Submit a Completed Form for the Sibling Who Is Missing a Form and a Corrected Form for T (3), From the Sample Reviewed, LS Did Not Observe Evidence of a Second Lead Test for Each Child and Did Not Observe Evidence of Lead Testing for One Child. Facility Must Immediately Submit Evidence of the Second Lead Test or Evidence of an Appointment with a Health Care Provider to Obtain a Lead Test. (3), and It Was Reported That Lunches Are Not Being Properly Refrigerated. LS Observed Perishable Items Stored in Lunchboxes That Were in the Cubbies. Lunches Are Being Stored with Ice Packs and the Perishable Items Are Not Being Removed and Placed in the Refrigerator. (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
