Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed One Child in Care That Did Not Have an Emergency Form. (2), Licensing Specialist Was Not Notified Within 5 Days That Existing Resident in the Home Turned 18, Provider Did Not Submit Signed and Notarized Release Form to the Agency. (2), and Licensing Specialist Was Not Notified Immediately of a Change of Resident at the Provider's Residence. Provider Stated That Her Mother Moved Back Into the Home Five Months Ago. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
