Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were In Room 4, the Baseboard by the Diapering Area Is Off of the Wall. There Was Peeling Paint on the Fence in the Toddler Playground. (1), In Room 4 the Door to the Classroom Had Stains, There Was Stains on the Wall by the Diaper Changing Area, There Were Brown Stains on the Diaper Genie, the Door Frame in the Bathroom Was Stained, the Trash Can Was Stained and the Closet Door Was Stained. These Areas Were Cleaned During the Inspectio (1), and The Playground Did Not Have Mulch Under the Swings. (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
